Content :	<p>Article 1 These Standards are promulgated according to Article 92 of the Telecommunications Management Act (hereinafter referred to as the Act).</p> <p>Article 2 With regard to applications for radio frequency allocation review by telecommunications enterprises according to Paragraph 1, Article 53 of the Act, the review fees are as follows:</p> <p>Mobile communications network frequency allocation: NT\$1 million per piece.</p> <p>Newly established satellite communications network (or satellite system) radio frequency allocation: NT\$1 million per piece.</p> <p>Additional or modified radio frequencies in existing satellite communications networks: NT\$500,000 per piece.</p> <p>Application for allocation of satellite communications network frequencies at the expiry of the frequency use period based on the original allocated frequencies: NT\$5,000 per piece.</p> <p>Article 3 Applicants who have paid the fees as stipulated in these Standards may not request a refund, except in the case of overpayment, payment by mistake or as otherwise provided for in the regulations.</p> <p>Article 4 The Standards shall become effective on August 27, 2022.</p>
